REVIEW OF JUNE 06, 2019 JAPC NOTES

The Committee reviewed the notes from the June meeting. The July JAPC was cancelled.

DISCUSSION TOPICS

ACCIDENT ANALYSIS

The Committee was provided with the LA/LB injury summary report covering 05/11/2019 to 07/16/2019 [pmap5060]. The report listed 26 LT and 50 NLT injuries for LA/LB. Direct employers provided additional information on 20 of the injuries. Members were reminded to review the injury report and follow-up with either the employer or the Secretary if additional information/details are requested.

The 2019 Mid Year Safety Summary Report was provided to the committee reflecting the lost time injury rate for the Coast and LA/LB.

SERIOUS ACCIDENTS

1. The Committee was made aware of an incident in which a n OTR truck made a sudden turn and collided with a shuttle van. Several occupants of the van were jostled with minor injuries.
2. A POLA container terminal safety manager provided details on a recent injury in which a semi tractor driver parking chassis turned directly into a passing vehicle striking the bombcart.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Working at Heights Subcommittee

The tentative date for the summer crane rescue drill is scheduled for 9/5/2019 at Fenix Marine.

2. Fuel Barge Refueling

Nothing new discussed. [Held Over].

3. Local 13 Letter to Employers re: Incident Data Collection on Top Handlers vs Pick Up Trucks

Nothing new discussed. [Held Over]. The Employers agreed to work with the Union on developing a form.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Local 13 letter re: Training Needs in LA/LB

Local 13 noted a letter will soon be sent to PMA on the training skills necessary for longshore work in LA/LB. [Letter was emailed on 8/8/19].

2. Update on Workforce Development Grant

An update on the Workforce Development grant was provided. The first round of students has completed the lashing pilot training program. The pre-training failure rate was 97%, with the post training passing rate of 93%.

3. Marine Terminal Trauma Bag

Local 13 requested that each marine terminal employer has an adequately equipped trauma bag for use during a major medical incident. The trauma bag can be stored with the safety manager, but should include additional items (such as blankets and tarps) beyond a standard FA kit.

4. First Aid / CPR Class for ILWU Members

Local 13 requested a yearly date be scheduled for a non-paid FA/CPR class made available to ILWU members, per PCMSC Rule 309.

5. Terminal Data Connectivity in Vehicles

Local 63 expressed concern over multiple "data dead zones" for clerk vehicles. Clerks are having to go park outside their work area to get coverage.
