**2015 INTERNATIONAL ELECTION CANDIDATES** – Local 63 has invited all of the candidates running for the various offices/committees to address our Membership at the August Stop Work meeting. Please plan on attending so that you may hear what they have to offer and make an informed decision at election time.

**2015 INTERNATIONAL ELECTION** – Ballots will be mailed by the International election vendor by July 27<sup>th</sup> with a deadline for return of the ballots by September 10<sup>th</sup>. Should a member not receive a ballot by August 3<sup>rd</sup>, he/she should call 1-800-864-1263 to obtain a replacement ballot.

**DOUBLE BACK ON 30% JOBS** – At the May Membership Meeting a motion was passed that directed the Executive Board to put together a process to allow Clerks to double back on 30% jobs. This issue has been discussed with the Executive Board, the Dispatchers and the JPLRC several times and at the July Executive Board meeting a motion was passed to approve the process that was drafted. This issue will be presented at the August Membership meeting for consideration.

**SICK DUES** – A motion was passed at the July Executive Board to increase the sick dues from the current amount of only per capita and pro-rata to the full dues amount less \$100. This would require a constitutional change and therefore is required to be read and approved at two (2) membership meetings and then put to a mail ballot for final approval. Please plan on attending the August Membership meeting to discuss this important issue.

**PAID HOLIDAY, TUESDAY, JULY 28<sup>TH</sup> – HARRY BRIDGES BIRTHDAY** – Is a normal work day, and an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2014. For those members who did not meet the automatic holiday requirements, they must be available for work at least two (2) of the four (4) days exclusive of the holiday (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> or 31<sup>st</sup>). If a member worked less than 1300 hours but at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2014 and is on disability during the holiday week, he/she must request the Business Office to file a claim on their behalf or if on vacation during the holiday week, notify the Records Clerk. *Reminder – only those members who **WORKED** at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2014 are entitled to receive or file for paid holidays in 2015.*

**REGISTRATION & NEW TRANSFERS REMINDER** – Applications for transfer to Clerks will be available for a period of 30-calander days beginning Thursday, July 9<sup>th</sup> through Friday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Applications will be available at the Local 13 Records Office through Ray Pearson. In addition, the CLRC agreed to the limited (Class B) registration into Local 13 of 600 Port of LA/LB identified Casuals.

**ILWU-LOCAL 63 2015 FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND** – Is created, organized and funded by ILWU fellow brothers and sisters. Sons and daughters of Local 63 members who are in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade or current college students are eligible to apply for a monetary award to be used for tuition or books.
