CURRENT APPENDIX, SECTION 1. MEETINGS (D).

All members are required to attend the regular members meeting of the Local or be fined five dollars (\$5.00). This shall not apply to members who are sick (doctor's certificate), injured (or Worker's Compensation), working or on vacation (maximum one (1) meeting per year). In addition, members shall be entitled to be excused from attending any two (2) meetings per year. Furthermore, members sixty (60) years of age or over, who have five (5) years as a Class "A" Marine Clerk, and have cleared with the Business Office, are also excused.

Are you in favor of revising Appendix, Section 1., Meetings (D) to read as follows:

All members are required to attend the regular membership meeting of the Local or be fined **twenty dollars (\$20.00)**. This shall not apply to members who are sick (doctor's certificate), injured (or Worker's Compensation), working or on vacation (maximum one (1) meeting per year). In addition, members shall be entitled to be excused from attending any two (2) meetings per year. Furthermore, members sixty (60) years of age or over, who have five (5) years as a Class "A" Marine Clerk, and have cleared with the Business Office, are also excused.
