Labor Day - September 3, 2018

Under the terms of the ILWU-PMA Agreements, Labor Day, Monday, September 3, 2018, is a no work holiday. No work will be performed from 8:00 a.m. Monday, September 3, 2018, until 7:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 4, 2018 except for passenger ships, essential military cargo, DST rail, and emergencies, as defined in Section 5.24 of the Contract. In addition, Longshore Mechanics can be directed to monitor reefers, pursuant to Section 2.43 of the L.A.-Long Beach Mechanics Port Supplementary Agreement.

Note: The no work provision does not apply to passenger vessels, essential military cargo, and emergencies.

LONGSHORE WORKERS AND MARINE CLERKS - LOS ANGELES/LONG BEACH

Gangs, Longshore Workers, and/or Marine Clerks working Sunday, September 2, 2018, may be given comebacks for Tuesday, September 4, 2018. **Rail labor must be released and re-ordered for Tuesday, September 4, 2018, if not brought back on Monday, September 3, 2018.**

DEADLINE FOR ORDERING AND CANCELING LONGSHORE AND CLERKS

All orders for Monday, First, Second, and Third Shifts, and Tuesday, First Shift, must be placed no later than 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, September 2, 2018. The deadline for cancellations is 3:00 p.m.

The deadlines for placing/canceling rail orders remain unchanged throughout the three-day holiday period.

DEADLINE FOR ORDERING AND CANCELING FOREMEN

Orders for Foremen for Monday, First, Second, and Third Shifts, and Tuesday, First Shift, must be placed with the Dispatch Hall no later than 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, September 2, 2018. The deadline for cancellations is 1:30 p.m.
