<u>PAID HOLIDAY - SUNDAY, JULY 4TH - INDEPENDENCE DAY</u> – Is an automatic holiday and a normal workday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over in 2020). Those members who worked at least 800 hours (700 hours if age 60 or over) but less than 1300 (1200 if age 60 or over) must work two (2) of the three (3) days that week exclusive of the holiday – Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, July 6th, 7th, 8th, or 9th, to qualify for the paid holiday, or if out on disability during that week, must request that the Business Office file a holiday claim on their behalf with the appropriate medical documentation covering them for that week. *Remember, only members who worked* at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in the previous year are entitled to file a holiday claim or receive holiday pay.

<u>NO WORK HOLIDAY – MONDAY, JULY 5th - BLOODY THURSDAY</u> – Is a dead day. As was agreed to in past negotiations, Bloody Thursday is a no work holiday but is **NOT** a paid holiday. No work shall be performed between 8:00 a.m. July 5th and 8:00 a.m. July 6th, except for military cargo, passenger vessels, and on-dock rail.

<u>ID CARDS MAILED TO NEW CLERKS</u> – New transfers should have received picture ID cards in the mail before the July 1st Regular Membership Meeting. These identification cards are used for logging attendance at meetings. Contact the Business office if you did not receive yours. New members must attend July 1st Membership meeting for swearing in!

<u>PAID HOLIDAY, WEDNESDAY, JULY 28th - HARRY BRIDGES BIRTHDAY</u> – Is a normal work day and an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2020. For those members who did not meet the automatic holiday requirements, they must be available for work at least two (2) of the four (4) days exclusive of the holiday (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday: July 26th, July 27th, July 29th, or July 30th.

If a member worked less than 1300 hours but at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2020 and is on disability during the holiday week, he/she must request the Business Office to file a claim on their behalf with the appropriate medical documentation covering them for that week, or if on vacation during the holiday week, notify the Records Clerk. Remember, only members who worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in the previous year are entitled to file a holiday claim or receive holiday pay.



July 4, 2021 - Independence Day July 5, 2021 - Bloody Thursday

Sunday, July 4, 2021, Independence Day, is a holiday and a normal workday in which the overtime rate of pay applies. All ILWU Longshore, Foremen, and Marine Clerk Locals in Southern California will be available for work. Since Independence Day, July 4, falls on a Sunday this year, under Section 5.21 of the Agreement, the following Monday, July 5, is an overtime day.

Monday, July 5, 2021, Bloody Thursday, is a no-work holiday in accordance with Section 5.2 of the PCL&CA. Local 13, Longshore; Local 63, Marine Clerks; Local 94, Foremen; Local 29, San Diego; and Local 46, Port Hueneme; will perform no work from 8:00 a.m. July 5, 2021, until 7:00 a.m. July 6, 2021. The Joint Longshore Dispatch Hall will be open with a skeleton crew on July 5, 2021.

Exception: The no-work provision does not apply to passenger vessels, essential military cargo, on-dock and near-dock rail yards, per Section 1.21(g), Item 1, and emergencies, as defined in Sections 5.2 and 5.24 of the Master Agreement. In addition, Longshore Mechanics can be directed to monitor reefers, pursuant to Section 2.43 of the L.A.-Long Beach Mechanics' Port Supplementary Agreement. Pursuant to Section 5.21 of the PCL&CA, work performed under this exception shall be at the overtime rate of pay.

Men and gangs required back may be ordered back from Sunday, July 4, 2021, to Tuesday, July 6, 2021. Rail labor must be released and reordered for Tuesday, July 6, 2021, if not brought back on Monday, July 5, 2021.

The following schedule should be observed locally for placing and canceling orders:

Vessel and/or rail orders for Sunday, July 4, 2021, Nightside, Monday (Rails) and Tuesday, July 6, 2021, Dayside, must be placed with the PMA Allocator by 10:30 a.m. Sunday, July 4, 2021, and in the Dispatch Hall by 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, July 4, 2021.

For Locals 13 and 63, the deadline for canceling Sunday, Nightside is 1:30 p.m. and Tuesday, Dayside is Sunday by 3:00 p.m.

For Local 94, the deadline for canceling Sunday, Nightside, Monday (Rails) and Tuesday, Dayside is Sunday by 1:30 p.m.
