Constitutional Question

Current Article IV, Section 2.G Language

The candidates for Dispatchers, Board of Trustees, Executive Board, Grievance Committee, Promotions Committee, Membership Committee and Convention and/or Caucus Delegation, shall be elected by receiving the highest number of votes cast.

Proposed Article IV, Section 2.G Language (Bold, Underline)

The candidates for Dispatchers, Board of Trustees, Executive Board, Grievance Committee, Promotions Committee, Membership Committee and Convention and/or Caucus Delegation, shall be elected by receiving the highest number of votes cast, **with the exception that only two Dispatchers may be elected to be a Convention and/or Caucus Delegate. If more than two Dispatchers receive the highest number of votes cast for Convention and/or Caucus Delegate, only the two Dispatchers receiving the highest number of votes cast for Convention and/or Caucus Delegate shall be elected.**
