Memo Re: Air Quality Monitoring

On Friday night several agencies including LAFD, LBFD, LACoFD, CalOES, LAPP, and USCG responded to the fire aboard the docked container ship ONE HENRY HUDSON at YTI.

Due to hazmat identified aboard the vessel, LAFD, LAPP, and EPA conducted air monitoring at the pier, on surrounding terminals, and in the neighboring residential communities. While air quality readings in the smoke plume remained within normal ranges, Unified Command issued a precautionary shelter-in-place order for San Pedro and Wilmington residents out of an abundance of caution.

No notable air or water pollution has been detected. United States Coast Guard and Los Angeles Port Police air monitoring teams continue to assess air quality on the vessel, on terminals, and in the surrounding communities.
