CONSTITUTIONAL QUESTION

Proposed Constitutional Language (deletion in bold) ARTICLE X, Dues, Fees, and Assessments,

Section 1. DUES

C. All fines and assessments shall be payable before dues. Any member of this Local who fails to pay his dues for a period of three (3) months (except in case of sickness or injury) shall be dropped from membership for nonpayment of dues. Should a member once dropped from the rolls desire to reaffiliate with the Local, he shall be required to make a request in writing to the Local, his request will be voted upon at two (2) regular membership meetings of the Local and if accepted by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the members present at both meetings, he must pay twelve (12) months back dues, the full initiation and investigation fee which equals one hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus fines and assessments levied since leaving the Local.

Purpose for removing "(except in case of sickness or injury)" language:

Currently, there are members who go out on disability for extended periods of time. While these members are out on disability, they are not fulfilling their dues obligation to Local 63, but the Local is still financially responsible for paying the monthly Coast Pro Rata and Per Capita on their behalf to the Coast/International. These members accumulate large balances on their account, and the Local only gets paid if and when they return from disability. In many cases, these members never return back to work, and the Local is left with a large outstanding balance. This change will require members who are on disability to keep their sick dues current or be read out of the Local if they fail to pay sick dues for a period of three (3) months or longer.
